Please be advised that Alameda County Department of Environmental Health, the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) for CalRecycle, has received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment per Title 27, California Code of Regulations (27 CCR), Section 21665(c). This public notice was prepared pursuant to Title 27 CCR 21660.1.

Project Description: Alameda County Industries (ACI) is an existing transfer/processing facility operating under a full Solid Waste Facility Permit issued on January 3, 2012. The application package to amend the RFI requests the following changes:

1. Remove existing infeed conveyor and replace it with a new and repositioned infeed conveyor;
2. Install a new Old Corrugated Cardboard (OCC) screen (to improve recovery of OCC) and divert additional materials from the waste stream utilizing new sorting stations;
3. Install new catwalks and platforms to allow access to equipment;
4. Install new conveyors to move residuals to a new outdoor compactor that will directly load transfer trailers, reducing the need to store and bale residuals;
5. Construct 2nd floor mezzanine in the MRF Building to house relocated restrooms, lunch room, and supervisor office;
6. Provide bale storage and Household Hazardous Waste / ABOP (aerosol, batteries, oils and paint) storage under the 2nd floor mezzanine.

The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current Solid Waste Facility Permit.
