## PRESS RELEASE

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The **County of Alameda General Service Agency-Purchasing Department** has been awarded the prestigious 18<sup>th</sup> Annual Achievement of Excellence in Procurement Award (AEP) for 2013 from the National Procurement Institute (NPI). The AEP Award is earned by public and non-profit organizations that obtain a high application score based on standardized criteria. The judging criteria are: Innovation, Professionalism, E-Procurement, Productivity, and Leadership

This program encourages the development of excellence as well as continued organizational improvement to earn the award annually.

For 2013, there were 179 successful applicants, including 43 counties, 58 cities, 17 higher education agencies, 23 school districts, 23 special districts, and 15 state agencies.
