Dear Board Members:

Recommendation:

Adopt a Salary Ordinance amendment to establish the classification series of Application Systems Engineer I/II and III in the Information Technology Department to expand career opportunities for Programmer and System Analyst classifications.

Discussion/Findings:

We are recommending the new classification series of Job Code 1866PA, Application Systems Engineer I, Job Code 1867PA, Application Systems Engineer III, in the Information Technology Department (ITD). Creation of this classification series, is based on the review of the current class structure of ITD's Programmer and Systems Analyst series, which resulted in the need for a department specific, systems analysis, classification series aimed at expanding the breadth of opportunities within each single classification, and to provide career advancement for technical engineers in a highly competitive field.

Application Systems Engineer-I incumbents, work under general supervision to provide support for the County's information systems. They are responsible for designing, developing, analyzing, implementing and maintaining software, including enterprise class, multi-tier system. Positions in this classification are entry-level, and perform work in a limited scope, within procedural frameworks established by higher level positions. Successful demonstration of proficiency to perform duties of the higher level classification, Application Systems Engineer I's flexibly promote to the higher classification of Application Systems Engineer II.

Application Systems Engineer-II incumbents, work under general supervision to provide advanced technology acumen, assist with the architecture and design of business solutions, and develop and support the County's information systems. Positions in this classification are journey-level, and perform duties with a higher degree of independence and responsibility expected of positions at the journey level.

Application Systems Engineer-III incumbents, work under direction to provide though leadership and operational support for the County's information systems, architect business solution, and serve as a liaison between department/agency representatives and their party service providers. Positions in this class are senior-level and perform duties with greater independence. Additionally, this class serves as a mentor to the lower level Application Systems Engineers, and serves as a mentor toward their career advancement.

Financing:

Funds are available in the 2015-2016 budget appropriation to pay the cost resulting from this action.
