Time limitations shall be at the discretion of the Chair.

Pursuant to Board Policy: (1) Signs that obstruct the view of meeting attendees are prohibited during Board meetings; (2) Demonstrations that disrupt the meeting are prohibited; (3) Each Committee Member may request one continuance of any item to a meeting date within two that disrupt the meeting are prohibited; (3) Each Board Member may request one continuance of any item to a meeting date within two regularly scheduled meetings.
