**Summary/Action Minutes**

**I. Federal Legislative Update – CJ Lake**

**Schedule**

The House is in recess. The Senate was scheduled to be out this week, but they will come into session tomorrow to begin consideration of the House-passed foreign aid bills.

**Foreign Aid Package**

After months of delay, the House approved a slate of bills that account for nearly \$100 billion dollars in aid to Ukraine, Israel, and Taiwan. On Ukraine aid, the vote passed 311-112, with 210 Democrats and 101 Republicans voting in favor. On Israel funding, the bill passed 366-58, with 173 Democrats and 193 Republicans voting in favor. The Taiwan package cleared the chamber 385-34, with unanimous Democratic support. A separate bill with a variety of national security priorities (including a potential TikTok forced sale or ban) also cleared the chamber, 360-58.

The Senate is set to begin considering the House-passed bills on Tuesday. Preliminary votes are scheduled for that afternoon, including a procedural vote to invoke cloture. That vote will start the 30-hour clock before final passage, unless there's an agreement to vote before those 30 hours of debate are complete. Final passage is expected at some point this week.

Some Senators have already announced that they will offer amendments to the House-passed bills. These amendments will all be rejected, and the underlying bill is expected to easily clear the 60-vote threshold. At this point, the vast majority of the Senate Democratic Caucus and nearly half the GOP conference will vote for it.

## FY25 Appropriations

The Senate has put out its guidance and deadlines for FY25 appropriations subcommittee submissions. The various deadlines start on May 8<sup>th</sup> and run through May 15<sup>th</sup>. The House has yet to publish subcommittee deadlines.
