Wendy Still, Reimagine Adult Justice Project Manager and Special Advisor to the Public Protection Committee, presented a PowerPoint presentation on the Final Reimagine Adult Justice Report, with possible direction from the Public Protection Committee.

The Reimagine Adult Justice Initiative is a comprehensive initiative to evaluate and improve various aspects of jail operations and inmate programs in Alameda County. The key focus areas include enhancing re-entry services, evaluating federal inmate occupancy feasibility, exploring diversion and preventative services, maximizing funding opportunities for physical and mental health services, optimizing justice-involved population support systems and addressing racial and ethnic disparities.

Recommended next steps for implementation include:

- Transition the implementation phase of RAJ (Phase 2) to the Public Protection, Justice & Health Collaborative (PPJHC)
- Establish a RAJ Project Manager to lead the implementation of RAJ and CalAIM
- Execute a new contract with Researcher/Consultant Wendy Ware to help further the county's justice reform goals as it related to the Santa Rita Jail analysis
- Execute a contract with CalHPS to help build upon existing gains and strategies in the implementation of CalAIM for the justice-involved population
