

Known Urban Shield Trainees Involved in Fatal Shootings

Note: The inclusion of fatal shootings by police who participated in Urban Shield – before or after the shooting – is not meant to claim that the shooting was illegal or legal, justified or preventable. They range from cases in which cities have paid settlements to families of those killed to the case of Lovelle Mixon who fatally shot four policemen before he was killed. It is meant to document these incidents, and lead us to interrogate further, including questions about the relationship between law enforcement and the community.

This data is based only on names of 15 police agencies out of 42 that have participated in Urban Shield SWAT competitions, and for some agencies only for some years. Moreover, the names of officers involved in fatal shootings is only known for a portion of police agencies that have participated in Urban Shield, since this information is often not released.
