Summary/Action Minutes

I. Management Partners Presentation on Initial Findings of Phase I – Review, Assessment, and Proposed Next Steps of the Alameda County Permit Process for Public Works Agency, the Planning Department, Fire Department and Environmental Health Department Attachment

Alameda County leaders have been fielding complaints and comments from elected officials, developers, and other stakeholders about the development approval process. To inform executive leadership and elected officials about possible next steps, the County Administrator engaged Management Partners to document complaint issues about the County's land use and development approval processes.

During the engagement Management Partners interviewed staff across various departments involved in the development review process, some elected officials and five (5) applicants, to identify major themes and issues. The major areas of focus that resulted from the interviews fall into the following categories:

- Overall permitting process
- Project management and lack of interdepartmental coordination
- Inconsistent use of technology
- Inadequate staffing levels in some departments
- Community engagement challenges

Outline of Phase II

- Conducting additional interviews with County staff to obtain more detail about the permitting process, operations, and systems.
- Review of selected files to understand the actual process, timeline, and impediments
- Creating process maps to analyze workflows and identify process bottlenecks
- Assess the management system of the development review process, including technology, training, staffing, communications, and application of best practices.
