Assistant Deputy Director, Dale Hagen served as Secretary to the Board in Mr. Larry Brooks absence.

Department's Outreach Coordinator, Soni Johnson provided Directors with information on the Department's activities during National Lead Poisoning Prevention Week, October 25-31, 2020. The Department collaborated with numerous partnering organizations; increased social media activities in various social media platforms; created a "Together" video and updated the Department's website layout. Ms. Johnson indicated that the Department intends to continue promoting its services and lead poisoning awareness by working with a marketing company and radio stations. Directors thanked staff for their work and asked for budget information related to marketing strategies. Directors asked staff to report back on a future meeting on the Department's long-term outreach plan and engagement efforts.

3) Mobile Lead Testing Site

Mr. Dale Hagen informed Directors that the Department contracts with the State Department of Public Health Lead Poisoning Prevention Branch and as part of the deliverables provides case management services, educates families on lead poisoning prevention and works with medical providers to promote blood lead testing. The Department is currently working with both the Medi-Cal managed care plans in Alameda County to put on a provider webinar to highlight the more than usual importance of blood lead testing because of the Shelter-In-Place situation.

4) **Outreach and Education Monthly Report**

Lidice De La Fuente noted that the Direct Public Outreach section of the monthly report indicates that thus far, the Department is at 84% in reaching the goals and objectives for the fiscal year. Ms. De La Fuente attributes the significant increase to an increase in attendance in virtual collaboration meetings, which allows more individuals to participate in meetings.
