RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the Purchasing Agent, or her designee, to execute a contract (Master Contract No. 902466) to provide trucking services to the Alameda County Public Works Agency, for the term of 12/1/2024 - 11/30/2027, in the pooled amount of \$798,454, with the following contractors:

- A. All Cities Trucking Services, Inc. (Principal: Rajinder Randhawa; Location: Oakland); Procurement Contract No. 27310;
- B. A1 Trucking Svs., Inc. (Principal: Kamal Singh; Location: Oakland); Procurement Contract No. 27311; and
- C. D's Trucking Service, Inc. (Principal: Vladimir Montelongo; Location: Oakland); Procurement Contract No. 27312.

DISCUSSION/SUMMARY:

The Alameda County Public Works Agency (PWA) is responsible for the management and operations of infrastructure including streets, bridges, and flood control facilities, such as pump stations and stormwater conveyance infrastructure. PWA manages the planning, design, construction and maintenance of these facilities.

The trucking services requested include, but are not limited to, hauling of road materials, household waste, green waste, slide material, rock, and other debris. PWA also requires the trucking services to support storm damage and other emergency response and routine maintenance throughout Alameda County.

SELECTION CRITERIA/PROCESS:

PWA has determined that Alameda County does not currently have all the resources required to provide the full amount of trucking and hauling services needed to perform maintenance tasks necessary to ensure continued infrastructure and right-of-way safety.

PWA worked with General Services Agency (GSA)—Procurement to develop a Request for Quotation (RFQ), which was issued on April 18, 2024, posted on the County and GSA LinkedIn websites for 32 days, sent to the E-Gov Goods and Services — Current Contract Opportunities mailing service, and emailed to the Chambers of Commerce e-mail group. The RFQ was also advertised in The Inter-City Express on April 22, 2024, and the San Francisco Daily Journal on April 22, 2024. A vendor outreach was conducted on April 24, 2024, followed by one networking/bidders conference on the same day, which was attended by four attendees representing four vendors.

On May 20, 2024, five bidders submitted responses to the RFQ. Two bid responses were disqualified for failing to submit the Exhibit A – Bid Response Packet as required. The remaining three responses were evaluated by GSA-Procurement and PWA based on lowest pricing and meeting the County's requirements of the required trucking services. As stated in the RFQ, contracts will be awarded to a pool of bidders.

All three bidders are being recommended for award.

All Cities Trucking Services, Inc. (Certified Small: 21-00043; Expiration: 7/31/2025); A1 Trucking Svs., Inc. (Certified Emerging: 21-00019; Expiration: 10/31/2024); and D's Trucking Service Inc. (Certified Small: 24-00022; Expiration: 2/28/2026) are all certified Small Local Emerging Businesses (SLEBs).
